PROSECUTOR'S RESPONSE TO JEAN UWINKINDI'S (SECOND) REQUEST FOR ANNULMENT OF DECISION REFERRING CASE NO. MICT-12-25 TO RWANDA FOR TRIAL

- By request dated 28 December 2014, as supplemented by submissions dated 16
  January 2015,<sup>1</sup> Jean Uwinkindi seeks to revoke the order of the International
  Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda (ICTR), referring his case to Rwanda for trial.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. Uwinkindi made a parallel verbal request for revocation when he met with the monitors in his case.<sup>3</sup> Based on the monitors' report of Uwinkindi's request for revocation, the President of the Mechanism for International Criminal Tribunals (MICT) designated a trial chamber to consider whether pursuant to Article 6(6) of the Statute the referral order should be revoked.<sup>4</sup>
- In light of the President's order, Uwinkindi's request for revocation is most and no further relief is warranted until proceedings before the designated trial chamber are completed.
