THE TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals ("Trial Chamber" and "Mechanism", respectively);

NOTING the "Decision on Uwinkindi's Request for Revocation", issued by the Trial Chamber on 22 October 2015 at 12:42 h. ("Revocation Decision"), in which the Trial Chamber rejected Jean Uwinkindi's request for the revocation of the referral of his case to the Republic of Rwanda;1

BEING SEISED of the "Communication à la Chambre et au Procureur d'informations supplémentaires sur le dossier Uwinkindi Jean devant la Haute Cour (audiences du 15 et 20 octobre 2015", filed by Uwinkindi on 22 October 2015 at 13:45 h. ("Supplemental Submission"), in which Uwinkindi seeks to supplement his submissions in support of his request for the revocation of his case;2

NOTING that the Prosecution has not filed a response;³

CONSIDERING that, in the Revocation Decision, the Trial Chamber has already adjudicated on Uwinkindi's request for the revocation of his case4 and therefore the proceedings before the Trial Chamber in relation to this matter have come to an end;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

HEREBY DISMISSES the Supplemental Submission.
