Introduction

- Jean de dieu Kamuhanda hereby provides notice that he appeals from the Single Judge's Decision on Motion for Appointment of Amicus Curiae Prosecutor to Investigate Prosecution Witness GEK (16 September 2015)(the "Impugned Decision").
 - 2. The appeal is filed pursuant to Rules 90(J) and 108(I).
 - 3. He raises a single ground of appeal:

The Single Judge erred in law when finding, in paragraphs 10 and 11 of the Impugned Decision, that he lacked jurisdiction to appoint an *amicus curiae* prosecutor, an error that invalidated the decision dismissing the motion.

- 4. Mr. Kamuhanda requests that the Appeals Chamber vacate the Impugned Decision and remand the matter to the Single Judge for a decision on the merits of the motion.
- 5. Pursuant to Rules 90(J) and 108(I) and paragraph 22 of the *Practice Direction* on *Requirements and Procedures for Appeals*, Mr. Kamuhanda will file his appeal brief within 15 days.
